- Residents of Cambridge, Somerville, and the surrounding communities.
- Children from birth to age 18 who have been exposed to domestic violence, and their parents

Who We Are

- We collaborate with area domestic violence agencies and other service providers.
- We work with families to assess their strengths, create stability, and build their sense of community.
- We are social workers, family therapists, and domestic violence advocates; we are family-centered and strive to be culturally responsive.
