Connect2Recovery is Riverside's supportive approach to helping people achieve not only recovery from mental health and substance addiction issues, but overall wellness – a healthy quality of life as defined by the individual. Connect2Recovery is designed to eliminate barriers to recovery, and support a person's chosen pathway to recovery.

SERVICES WE OFFER:

Community Support Program (CSP)

The CSP provides case management and care coordination for people living with mental health challenges who are at high risk for inpatient services.

Eligible individuals must have a mental health diagnosis and one of the following situations:

- An inpatient stay within the past 180 days
- Multiple emergency responses or emergency department visits in the past 90 days
- Barriers to accessing essential behavioral health or medical services

A primary care physician can also refer a person for assistance and necessary medical follow-up.


Certified Peer Specialist (CPS)

A CPS is a person in recovery with lived experience with mental health, substance use, or co-occurring challenges. They provide peer support based on shared experiences and offer advocacy, resources, and hope. To be eligible for CPS services, a person must have a mental health diagnosis, and be able to benefit from the support of a peer.

Connect2Recovery Services are available to members of a MassHealth managed care plan (including MBHP, Fallon, Tufts, and WellSense), and Medicaid/Medicare.
