SUBSTANCE USE SERVICES

Connect2Recovery is Riverside's supportive approach to helping people achieve not only recovery from mental health and substance addiction issues, but overall wellness – a healthy quality of life as defined by the individual. Connect2Recovery is designed to eliminate barriers to recovery, and support a person's chosen pathway to recovery.

SERVICES WE OFFER:

Recovery Support Navigator (RSN)

The navigator provides support and resource connections to an individual who has a substance use disorder diagnosis and one of the following situations:

- An inpatient stay (detox or other) in the past 180 days
- Multiple emergency responses or emergency department visits in the past 90 days
- Barriers to behavioral health or medical services
- Loss of either employment, housing stability, or family support
- Change in medication-assisted treatment (MAT) protocol
- Pregnancy or up to 12 months postpartum (both partners eligible)
- Incarceration

Recovery Coach (RC)


The coach provides peer support to an individual eligible with a diagnosis of substance use disorder, along with one of the following:

- Attempting to achieve recovery
- Could benefit from any or all:
 - Education about recoverySupportive encouragement to
 - Supportive encouragement to motivate change
 - Connection to a recovery community
 - Recovery Wellness Plan
- Pregnancy or up to 12 months postpartum (both partners eligible)
